Some of you have been wondering about all of the construction that has been taking place at the rectory for the past couple of months. I have asked Denise and Mike Reiner to help fill everyone in on what has taken place over the past few years. Maybe when it is all done we'll have an open house so people can see what was done.

Father Phil asked the CCW group to come into the rectory and do a deep clean prior to Father Garrett's arrival, as the rectory was in need of floor to ceiling cleaning. CCW leadership had 50 plus parishioners including younger members of our parish help with this and many of us had never seen the rectory in its entirety. Needless to say, the rectory was in need of repair and replacement of the old furniture. Mike and I offered to do a walk through with Father Garett, once he had settled in.

Father Garrett had taken the task upon himself, to remove carpets from some of the bedrooms, refinish the maple floors and create a chapel for daily prayers. He and his dad also pulled carpet out of the pastor's bathroom, added a much needed vanity and painted.

In April 2021, a small group including 2 administrative council members performed this walk through with suggested ideas based on what was found during the rectory cleaning and assessment of what was not working.

The air conditioning units that were mounted upstairs and downstairs were not in working order. This may have contributed to the mold that was found in some of the rooms upstairs when cleaning. We put together multiple suggestions including updating the air conditioning, a repair of many of the plaster ceilings, some of which had temporary fixes done in the past. Make a second shower upstairs functional. The downstairs kitchen was in need of updates, lighting was poor with a single noisy fluorescent light, prior cupboards had been refinished many years prior. The washer and dryer were historically installed into the small pantry in the kitchen, resulting in plaster peeling off the ceiling and walls. A recommendation was made to move the washer and dryer upstairs, repair the pantry, increase the lighting and recess the refrigerator into the space under the stairs to allow movement in the kitchen. It was also suggested to replace the cupboards, countertops to allow better storage and brighten the kitchen. Ceiling repair in the dining room was requested to fix the remaining panels. There were other improvements as part of the walk through some them relating to window treatment repairs etc.

This list was compiled and sent to the administrative group, where further actions were taken by the council members to procure services, products etc. for the project.

There have been donations to the rectory for specific furniture pieces, art work, stain glass window etc.
