With our entrance into the month of May, things are really starting to pick up speed as we race to the end of our school year and our farmers hit the fields for planting. The hope of summer is invading our bones as some long-overdue warmth finally dispels winter's chill. And there is also a lot going on in our parishes these days.

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to our Blessed Mother, the Virgin Mary. As Springtime brings the excitement of new life, Mary reminds us of the Life that gestated for nine months within her sacred womb—Jesus our Savior, who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. It's so important to cultivate a devotion to our Blessed Mother Mary. She offers us an example of humility, docility toward the will of God, and prayer. She is the only person in the Scriptures greeted as "full of grace;" she is the Mother of the Church, and the Queen of Heaven—and she is a powerful intercessor and mediator for us to God. At St Raphael's school, we celebrated the coronation of our Mother at the school Mass this Friday (5th May). I encourage you all to incorporate a devotion to Mary during this month: even something as simple as a Hail Mary at the end of the day, a decade of the rosary while driving to work, or bringing a flower to lay at the foot of her statue at the Church.

This weekend, at St Raphael, we will be honoring our graduating seniors of Springfield High School with the Baccalaureate Mass on Saturday evening. This is always a special time to pray for our soon-to-be graduates: even as they are filled with excitement and enthusiasm for their future, they are also a little frightened, nervous, and uncertain. With our prayers we support them and commend them to God's care. My prayer for them, in particular, is that they would be made strong in faith and encouraged in fostering a meaningful relationship with Jesus through prayer, the sacraments, friendship with fellow believers, and service.

It is also a big weekend for the **second graders at St Raphael's Church who will be making their First Communion this Sunday!** Just last weekend we celebrated this special moment at St Joseph's Church—and as I mentioned last week, as our young children for the first time make this act of communion in the life of Jesus through the Eucharist, it should be a powerful reminder for all of us: we come again and again to this sacrament of communion so that, over time, we would grow more devout, more grateful, and more attune to the spiritual reality into which we are drawn by Jesus. I am certainly grateful to our catechists who have prepared them for this sacrament, and those who will continue to nurture them in the faith in the years ahead. I also encourage our parishioners to pray not only for our first communicants, but also for their families and for ourselves; that we would be inspired by the beauty of this great sacrament and strengthen by the grace it communicates to us to remain in Jesus and to follow Him ever more faithfully.

Finally, just a word regarding *next weekend* (13/14 May); because of the large number of students involved in the annual Promenade at Springfield Public Schools, we will be having an extra Mass next weekend to which we are inviting the students attending Prom and their immediate family. The Prom Mass, which will be earlier on Saturday evening, is open to all students, even those who do not belong to St Raphael parish. We will have our normal weekend Masses, at their usual times, available for the rest of our parishioners.

Let us keep one another in our prayers during these first days of May.


