Let's keep little Matty Krueger and his family and friends in our prayers for a while. It was a very difficult week for many of us to celebrate a funeral mass for a little boy who died so unexpectedly.

Let's also keep Pickle Riley and his family and friends in our prayers as well after we celebrated his funeral mass last week as well (I don't think I am ever going to get used to calling someone Pickle, but I had to start because everyone else did!).

Any finally, let's keep Gary Reese and his family and friends in our prayers. We celebrated his funeral mass this week.

I know that most of you at St. Joseph's in Lamberton are aware that Sue Imker has been hired on to help replace some of the administrative duties that were waiting to be filled since sister left last year. Please greet her and thank her for coming on board to help us. It may take awhile to figure out how this new position will run efficiently. This is something new for us as far as I can tell, and we'll do the best that we can.

Recently I was reminded of the importance of the Eucharist in the life of St. John Paul II by several quotes I ran across on his feast day on October 22nd. He was and is a real hero of mine. I had the privilege of meeting him twice in his residence when I was a student in Rome in 1999. I'll never forget walking into his private chapel at 7 a.m. for mass with a few other people and the impact that had on me. The intensity of his love for Jesus present in the tabernacle was palpable and I hope to share some of what I've learned from him throughout my time with you. You could tell that was fuel where he was filled up to then pass that love of God on to us through his heart. There is an entire generation of priests who had the same gift meeting him and encountering what I am sharing with you. He helped us to come to know the power of God present in the Eucharist and how it is a wellspring of grace to be received and given. And if you ever think I am just pulling your leg and making this whole thing up I have the pictures hanging in the rectory.

Here is a quote for you this week, "The Eucharist is the secret of my day. It gives strength and meaning to all my activities of service to the Church and to the whole world ... Let Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament speak to your hearts. It is he who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us: He is God with us. Seek him *without tiring*, welcome him *without reserve*, love him *without interruption*: today, tomorrow, forever!" — <u>Address to young people of Bologna</u>, Sept. 27, 1997
