Back to Canon Law...

Can. 531 Although another person has performed a certain parochial function, that person is to put the offerings received from the Christian faithful on that occasion in the parochial account, unless in the case of voluntary openings the contrary intention of the donor is certain. The diocesan bishop, after having heard the presbyteral council, is competent to establish prescripts which provide for the allocation of these openings and the remuneration of clerics fulfilling the same function.

This one isn't as interesting as some of the others that we have been covering. But I want to continue the education until the end. So, what does the canon above mean? To make it short and sweet, when someone gives the pastor money, a "stole fee" for celebrating a sacrament, that money is to go to the parish unless the family says it is to go to the cleric who celebrated the baptism, wedding, funeral etc... So, from now on, when you give me, or Deacon Barry, or another visiting priest any money for celebrating a sacrament, doing a blessing or some other clergy "thing", know that the money goes back to the parish unless you say you want us to keep it as a gift.




