Hello everyone,

With the various activities that have been taking place lately I just want to take the time to thank everyone for their time and talent at the service of our parishes and Catholic school in our AFC.

Last weekend we took up a second collection for those suffering from the effects of the terrible fire in Hawaii. If you were not around this past weekend to contribute to the second collection, feel free to simply drop a marked envelope in the normal collection. Because the Diocesan Update does not come out until Thursday evenings and the bulletin needs to be done by Thursday morning, there will always be a communication lag with special collections asked for by our bishop. We will do the best we can to get information out to you in a timely manner.

The weekend of September 10<sup>th</sup> we will be taking up a second collection for the Catholic University of America. This is something we do in our diocese every year.

It's time for me to do a little selling/advertising...

I'm looking forward to spending time with you at St. Raphael's parish festival on September 10<sup>th</sup>. I'll be carrying around a colorful backpack as part of a fundraiser for the live auction that day. You'll be able to stuff all sorts of cash, gifts, gold, silver, and jewels in it as part of the festivities. This is new to me, and the pack is colorful to get your attention I suppose. It's probably better that I did not pick out the color otherwise it may have been hunting camouflage and no one would have seen it and put anything in it. I wonder how much it will be worth when the bidding on it starts.

An Italian meal is being auctioned off at the parish festival and I have agreed to cook it at the rectory for a party of eight. The menu has not been set and can be negotiated to a degree with whoever wins the bid. If you are nervous about my cooking skills that is understandable. How would you know if I can cook or not? All I can say is that I have taken two cooking classes in Rome and have lead more pilgrimages with teens and adults to that country than I can remember. You could say that much experience could qualify someone as a pasta snob. It is up to you if you want to take the chance to bid on such a culinary experience to help support St. Raphael's parish. A sample menu:

Antipasto – a charcuterie board of fine Italian meats and cheeses imported from Italy with salami from Norcia, prosciutto from Parma and San Danielle, olives from Tuscany, cheeses from Parma, Assisi and Rome.

Primo – Spaghetti alla Bolognese, Heart attack pasta or some other type of pasta. Today I saw some fresh made Italian sausage in our grocery store in town and decided to try experimenting with it and made a new sauce that has San Marzano tomatoes, fresh garlic, crushed red pepper etc.... It's marinating in the refrigerator right now and hopefully it leads to something delicious soon. Maybe it will be a steppingstone for a vodka sauce. We'll see.

Secondo – depends on the time of year. This is a meat and vegetable dish. Some nice grilled meat with a morel mushroom cream sauce and asparagus?

Greetings!

**Great Start:** This week was only our second week of school, and things are already running smoothly! The teachers and staff have been establishing important routines and procedures. Classroom teachers have been administering diagnostic testing for grouping and to see what their student's educational needs are. We will be meeting as a staff several times a month after school for our staff meetings. These meetings ensure that the staff communicates important information, routines, and policies. This year our focus will be on developing several areas of the curriculum such as math and social studies.

**New Breakfast Program:** With the new Minnesota legislation, all students get free lunch and breakfast. Our food Manager Erin Meine has done an amazing job getting our new breakfast program up and running. When students arrive at school, they immediately go down to the cafeteria for breakfast! Students are already in a good routine of coming downstairs for breakfast and everything is running very smoothly.

**Daycare Update:** We are in the final stages of obtaining licensure and Katie has begun the process of registering families! Our opening date is September 11th. We are so thrilled to finally see this project to completion and begin serving families in this way. Thanks so much to Katie Pierson who has done so much work to get our daycare up and running. She has done a phenomenal job! We plan to host an Open House this fall so that donors and parishioners can see the hard work we've put into the project.

**Steeple Chase--Change in Date:** Our schools' annual 5K fun run/walk, the Steeple Chase, is moving from the weekend of the Fall Festival to Friday October 6th! It will work differently this year by having the event during the school day to get all of our students involved. Right now, t-shirts are being designed for our 11th annual Steeple Chase. Businesses will be once again asked to sponsor this event and the names of their businesses will go on the backs of the shirts if they have a \$50+ donation. Students will be asked to get pledges for the walk/run as well. The walk/run will be open to school families, parishioners, and members of the community. We invite everyone to join us!
