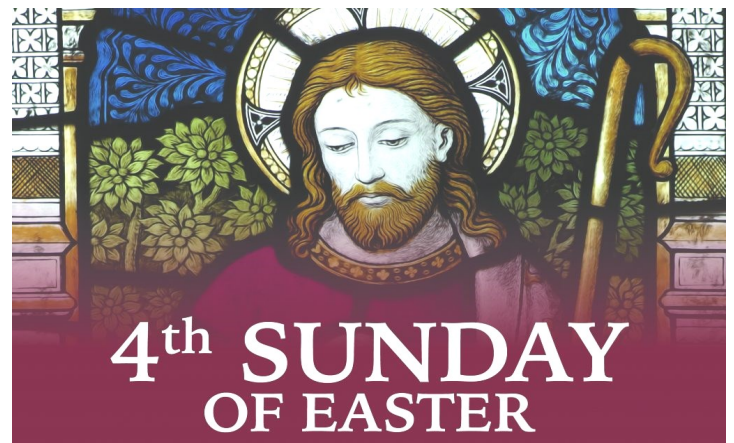

## ~St. Raphael School~

*It is the mission of St. Raphael Catholic School to bring students to a deeper relationship with Jesus while providing excellent education.*

**Save the Date:** Our largest fundraiser of the school year is coming up on Friday May 31, 2024 from 5 PM- Midnight. This year marks our fourth annual "A Night in Havana" event. It is an adults only night out with many fun ways to entertain yourself for the evening! The event is free to attend and open to the public. It takes place in the parking lot of the church and school. This year, we will have a food truck that is available to purchase your meal, you can purchase drinks at our own Havana bar, bid on the silent and live auction items, purchase raffle tickets, and enjoy free live music by local bands Chris and Chris and The Blue Ringers. Come and join us for this fun fundraising event! All proceeds benefit St. Raphael Catholic School. **What is done with the funds raised from "A Night in Havana"?** Last year, \$90,000 of those funds went directly to the general school budget. This helps keep our tuition as low as possible for families, as well as be able to pay our staff a living wage. \$14,150 of those funds went toward our playground project and have been set aside for that purpose. \$20,000 of those funds were set aside in an investment which will help the sustainability of our school.

**On Sale Now!!!:** Raffle tickets are now available for purchase from students and the school office through the event on May 31st. We will once again be having a meat raffle, gift card raffle, and big ticket raffle--we will be giving away a 2024 Polaris Ranger! If you would like to purchase tickets, please see a St. Raphael Catholic School family or come to the school office! Thank you for all your support!

**NWEA Testing:** Our students are now taking their third and final NWEA tests for the school year. NWEA is a standardized testing tool that helps us monitor student growth as well as pinpoint areas of strength and areas of challenge. This helps our teaching staff know what students are ready to learn! The spring NWEA tests help parents and teachers see the growth that has been made since the fall and what areas to target for the remainder of the school year. It also helps me, as the administrator see strengths and weaknesses in our curriculum. Then, we use the data to make any changes necessary.

**K-6 Elementary School-Now Enrolling:** We are now enrolling students going into K-6th grade for the 2024-2025 school year. We offer a comprehensive faith-based education which includes daily prayer, weekly Mass, formal religion classes, language arts, math, science, social studies, technology, physical education, music, and art. Call the school office for a tour or to get more information 507-723-4135.

**Preschool-Now Enrolling:** *Although we will have a different teacher, we plan to keep doing what we do best at St. Raphael Catholic School--bringing students to a deeper relationship with Jesus while providing them with excellent education!!! I am confident we will find an excellent candidate and continue the legacy of an awesome preschool program at St. Raphael.* Registration is now open for the Little Panthers Preschool program (3 year olds) and our Kindergarten Readiness program (4 year olds). Our Little Panthers program meets on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8-11 AM and our Kindergarten Readiness program meets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8-11 AM. The cost is \$13.50 per day for each of our preschool programs. Students who are eligible for our program must be 3 years old before September 1, 2024 (Little Panthers) and 4 years old by September 1, 2024 (Kindergarten Readiness.) Students must also be potty trained and be able to use the bathroom independently. To register for the 2024-2025 school year, stop in to the school office to get a registration form and return it with your \$25 registration fee. You can also call the school office and we would be happy to mail a registration form out to you!

**Godly Virtues:** In April, we will be focusing on **forgiveness** which is pardoning those who offend you. We read this over our morning announcements every day and use it in the classrooms as we teach our students to follow Jesus. It has been fun to listen to students and staff and see how they bring the Godly virtues that we have learned so far into their day-to-day lives.
