The Mission of the Vine & Branches Area Faith Community empowered by the Holy Spirit is to bear fruit that will last as Jesus commanded: by celebrating and proclaiming our Catholic faith as disciples of Jesus using our God-given gifts; by reaching out to and welcoming all people; and by centering our lives on the Eucharist, sacraments, scripture, service and the teaching of the Church.

This bulletin article is a little bit strange for me to write this year. I have not been in the custom of writing articles every week at the former parishes that I served, and I am realizing that writing about Easter before it happens is not something that I enjoy or am really all that comfortable with as it distracts from being in the moment during Holy Week. So, I ask your pardon for not doing so and hope that the Easter message in the homily will suffice. For now, I just really look forward to celebrating the Triduum with you and entering into the most sacred mysteries of our faith with you. What an honor to walk with you and the Lord remembering so much of what he did for us and how we can return our worship to him and offer our hearts right back as we receive the totality of his once again.

One of the things that you'll notice on Holy Thursday and throughout the Triduum is that people from all the parishes in our AFC will be participating in the liturgies in some way, shape or form. It's clearly not the ideal to share a priest like we do, but this is nothing new for us in our rural parishes. As your pastor it's a way to bring everyone together and that I very much look forward to doing.

Something to put on the radar for St. Raphael parishioners... there is a possibility that we will have the opportunity to upgrade our organ from the current 12 ranks that we have to an organ with 42 ranks (I can't explain this in detail other than to say that the difference means it is cathedral worthy). It's possible that this would be a gift, but some expenses would come with installation, labor etc.... I will be visiting with a couple of choir members from St. Raphael who presented this opportunity, who know organs and have done a lot of work on them. We'll dig into this possibility and see if there is something to present to the rest of you. For now, I wanted you to be in the loop simply to take this to prayer and we can leave it in the Lord's hands to show us what he desires.

Thank you to the parishioners at St. Joseph's who moved the clergy parking sign to the back parking lot to free up some more handicapped parking out front. Make sure you take notice and use it. I'm over the hill, but not that far over yet where I need such a space.

A reminder to all St. Raphael parishioners and school families to please consider filling out the online survey for the capital campaign feasibility study. I value your input and the information you give will really help us in making decisions on how to move forward with the proposed projects. It never crossed my mind that a capital campaign would be something that would come up in my first year here. Not having years of experience under my belt in this area means I need your input more than you might think.

A reminder that the second week of Easter most of the priests of the diocese go on retreat with the bishop every year. I asked Bishop Zielinski what his intentions were for us priests and he told me that he wants all of us to join him. In a roundabout way what I am saying is that if you don't like that I will be gone... take it up with the boss (meant to be said in such a way that you are laughing right now). I pray that it will be a blessed time with true growth spiritually in our relationship with the Lord and as a fraternity of priests.

Be assured of my prayers for all of you during this most sacred time.





Happy Holy Week! Thank you all for your support and prayers for me at the students and staff of St. Raphael Catholic School. I pray that you have a Happy Holy Week and blessed Easter.

Now Enrolling: Registration is now open for the Little Panthers Preschool program (3 year olds) and our Kindergarten Readiness program (4 year olds). Our Little Panthers program meets on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8-11 AM and our Kindergarten Readiness program meets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8-11 AM. The cost is \$13.50 per day for each of our preschool programs. Students who are eligible for our program must be 3 years old before September 1, 2024 (Little Panthers) and 4 years old by September 1, 2024 (Kindergarten Readiness.) Students must also be potty trained and be able to use the bathroom independently. To register for the 2024-2025 school year, stop in to the school office to get a registration form and return it with your \$25 registration fee. You can also call the school office and we would be happy to mail a registration form out to you!

Godly Virtues: In March, we will be focusing on respect, which is acknowledging the dignity of all people. We read this over our morning announcements every day and use it in the classrooms as we teach our students to follow Jesus.
